Medication management for your upcoming procedure scheduled with Dr.Woo/Dr.Tesfaye

Medications:

- 1. Avoid NSAIDs for 7 days prior to your procedure.
- 2. If you are taking blood thinning medications for stroke, heart or blood clots, please consult with your Physician before your procedure.
- 3. Always take your blood pressure medication even on the day of your procedure with a little sip of water.
- 4. If you take diabetes medications, take a $\frac{1}{2}$ dose of your medications. You must discuss the management of these with your endoscopist or your prescribing physician ahead of time to decide on the timing of the doses.
- 5. If you are taking phentermines these medications need to be stopped 5 days prior to your procedure.
- 6. If you are taking GLP-1 receptor agonists (Ex: Ozempic, Wegovy, Rybelsus, Saxenda, Victoza, Trulicity, Byetta, Bydureon, Tanzeum, Adlyxine) these medications need to be stopped 1 week prior to your procedure.

You may take your morning medications with a little sip of water the day of your procedure.
